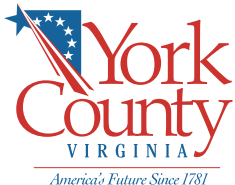

York County Outstanding Youth Award

Sponsored by the York County Board of Supervisors & York County Youth Commission

PURPOSE	To recognize and celebrate the accomplishments of outstanding York County high school students!
CRITERIA	<p>All nominees must be: a) York County residents; b) high school students in grades 9–12 (except 12th grade only for Overall Achievement); Students may attend public, private, or home school to be eligible; c) nominated for one of the following awards:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Compassion - Someone who consistently shows interest, sensitivity, and caring for people's problems and needs. Also, someone who regularly extends him or herself to help meet these needs through active service and involvement.2. Courage - May be interpreted in the traditional sense of rescue or an act of bravery. But, may also apply to someone striving to overcome an obstacle such as a disability, illness, undesirable social situation, or a pattern of undesirable behavior.3. Community Service - This category encompasses a variety of service activities such as volunteer work, tutoring, providing companionship to the sick or elderly, participating in charity fundraising, and other humanitarian service projects.4. Overall Achievement - This recognizes a 12th grader who is a standout in the community and who participates and excels in numerous activities. Areas of excellence could include: academic, leadership, service, and extracurricular activities and achievements at school; extracurricular activities and service outside of school (scouting, religious organizations, private volunteering, etc.); and, other activities such as special talents and awards (musical, drama, athletic, etc.), hobbies, and part-time or summer employment.
WHO CAN NOMINATE	<p>NOTE: Members of this year's 2022-2023 York County Youth Commission are not eligible to be nominated for the 2023 Outstanding Youth Awards.</p> <p>Any adult, teenager, group, or organization may nominate a student for one of the awards.</p>
DEADLINE	<p>Nominations must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 17, 2023. Please mail to Outstanding Youth Awards, c/o York County Parks & Recreation, P.O. SELECTION	<p>A Selection Committee comprised of two Youth Commission members, one member of the Board of Supervisors, and one York County School Board member will review the nominations and choose one award winner in each of the four categories listed above. The four recipients will be notified of their selections on or about April 18, 2023. All other nominees will be mailed a letter and Certificate of Recognition from the Board of Supervisors in late April commending them on their nomination and notifying them of their nominator.</p>
AWARDS	<p>The four recipients of a \$1,000 Educational Scholarship (for post-secondary college or trade school) will be formally recognized at the May 16, 2023, meeting of the York County Board of Supervisors. A dinner reception will be held prior to the Board meeting for the four recipients, their immediate families, and their nominators.</p>
