

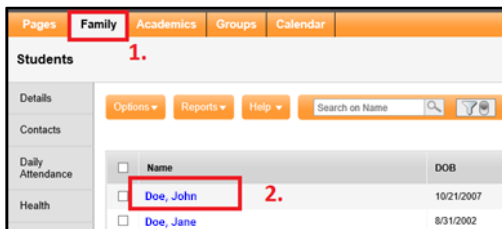
Dear Grade 3-8 Families,

The Virginia Department of Education has developed a new, secure, web-based platform, the Virginia Assessment Parent Portal (<https://va-results.pearsonaccessnext.com>). The portal offers families access to certain statewide assessments, including the results from the Fall 2022 Grades 3-8 Reading and Mathematics Growth Assessments, as well as the Spring 2022 Grades 3-8 Reading and Math Standards of Learning (SOL) results. This online platform replaces paper reports previously provided to families for grades 3-8 reading and mathematics.

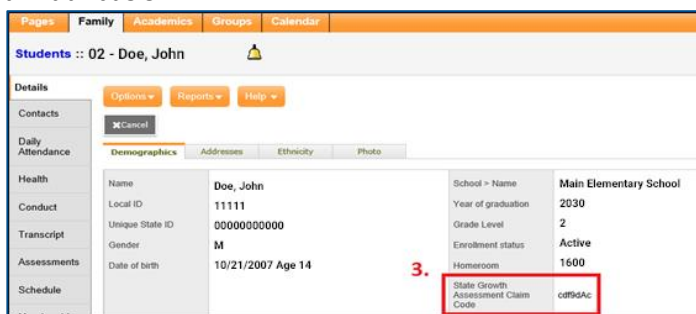
On this site, you will be able to review your child’s Student Detail by Question (SDBQ) Report for each test completed this school year in reading and mathematics and, in most cases, you will be able to view a personalized video that accompanies the SDBQ Report for your child. This personalized video provides an overview of the SDBQ report, explains specific details from your child’s SDBQ report, and directs you to resources on the Virginia Department of Education’s website (<https://tinyurl.com/VAporentpage>) to assist with your child's academic needs.

To create your personal Virginia Assessment Parent Portal account, log in to the [Aspen Parent Portal](#):

- Read the Virginia Assessment Parent Portal User’s Guide, located under Announcements.
- Create your state account and return to Aspen to retrieve each student’s individual claim code.
 1. Select the “Family” tab from the top navigation field
 2. Click on your child’s name to reach the “Details” tab (grades 3-8 only)



3. Locate the individual child’s Claim Code in the bottom, right hand column. **Please note, the Claim Code must be entered exactly as shown as it is case sensitive. Claim codes are updated on an annual basis.**



4. Enter the Claim Code in the Virginia Assessment Parent Portal.
