Scholarship Application Procedure

The applicant must submit:

- All requested information on the application form (must be typed) and submitted electronically via the provided link
- Two (2) letters of recommendation; one (1) from a school instructor or guidance counselor and one (1) from a person in the community who can speak to the applicant's character and community involvement
- An official transcript which shows the most recently available grades

Two letters of recommendation and official transcript must be emailed or mailed to the email address/postal address provided on page 1 of this document.

Scholarship Criteria

The Bobbye Burns Alexander Scholarship

Mrs. Bobbye Burns Alexander was a lover of mathematics. Her career as an educator spanned over 35 years. She was instrumental in the implementation of the ACT-SO (Afro-Academic, Cultural, Technological and Scientific Olympics) program, which encourages students to explore STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) topics. The Bobbye Burns Alexander Scholarship will be awarded to an individual pursuing a degree in a STEM related field and enrolled for Summer/Fall 2023.

The Gloria Wingo Wallace Scholarship

Mrs. Gloria Wingo Wallace was an educator who lived life to the fullest. She loved playing bridge and pinochle, traveling and reading a good novel. She also had great affection and love for two HBCU's (Historically Black Colleges and Universities). She began her post-secondary education at Norfolk State University and obtained her degree from Virginia State University. The Gloria Wingo Wallace Scholarship will be awarded to an individual pursuing a degree at an HBCU and enrolled for Summer/Fall 2023.

The Lambda Lambda Omega Scholarship

Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated was the first Greek letter organization of its kind. The organization pioneered mobile health clinics in America, has been a leader in the fight against illiteracy, and has the distinction of being one of only a handful of women's organizations to operate a federally funded Job Corps. Ever since Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. awarded its first scholarship in 1914 (\$10 to a liberal arts student at Howard University), one program of service has endured—scholarships. The Lambda Lambda Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., is pleased to continue to award scholarships to graduating seniors as they pursue the next level of education. The Lambda Lambda Omega Scholarship will be awarded to an individual pursuing an education at an institution of higher learning (college, technical or specialized school) and enrolled for Summer/Fall 2023.
