Dear Falcon Families,

I have missed seeing you all on Siege Lane and I think of you daily. Please take a moment to read this important information to ensure that you have important information about the fourth quarter.

YES will be holding a **medication pick up** date on Wednesday April 15th from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. If your student has medication or supplies at the YES clinic, please plan to pick up these items on this date. Following the CDC recommendations for social distancing, medications and supplies will be available on a drive-up basis only. For pick up, pull up to the front of the school building and our nurse will be out to meet you with your items. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact Nurse Philipoom at 898-0358.

Spring pictures and yearbooks that were ordered prior to the school closure will be printed. Personal items that remain in the school are still safely in their place. Delivery will be arranged at a later date following CDC guideline and with the guidance of YCSD.

YCSD has developed Instructional Learner Plans containing instructional activities for all students from PreK-5th grade to ensure continued instruction during the extended school closure. Due to inclement weather today, starting tomorrow (4/14) at 10:00 a.m. families will have the opportunity to stop by YES to pick-up the new instructional learner plans. These plans will cover the timeframe of 4/13-4/24 and will be developed bi-weekly and will be available for families for the remainder of this school year.

The learner plans do not contain new material but provide a continuity of learning allowing student exposure to previously taught material. However, beyond the daily instructional options, families are provided extended activities found within the plans and families are encouraged to try these activities when looking for variety. Please note, technology is not needed to complete activities in the plans and printing the learner plan is not necessary. All learner plans are available on the YCSD website, teachers have posted them on Aspen, and printed copies can be picked up outside YES from grade level tubs that will be placed in front of the main entrance on 04/14.

There are limited quantities of the printed copies of the learner plan. Because of this, we kindly ask families only pick up one learner plan per student in your family. We encourage families to access the plans online, if possible, in order to maintain safety during these unsettling times.

Starting the week of April 13, your child's teacher will be reaching out to your family weekly to provide support and answer questions. If you do not hear from the teacher, please reach out to me so that I can make sure support is provided to your family. Even though we are not together in the school building, we are still together in spirit and the YES faculty and staff are here to support you every step of the way.
