School Parking Regulations

Students who do not have permits to park on campus may not park on school grounds during the school day (7:00 a.m. to 2:15 p.m.). Vehicles without parking permits are prohibited and may be towed (at owner's expense).

Parking fees are \$100 per year and are non-refundable. Permits are requested by the year only. Applications are available in the main office and upon completion should be submitted to the THS main office for approval, if parking spaces are still available.

Reminder - Tardy Policy

Tabb High School continually strives for academic excellence for all of our students. However, in order to achieve this we must have your participation. Please make sure you make every effort to be on time to class and to school each morning. You never know what you may be missing!

As per the student handbook, students should be in all classes on time. If a student is going to be late to their first class, a parent or guardian must supply a note indicating the reason for the tardiness and give this note to the attendance office. The determination whether or not a tardy is excused or unexcused is determined by

administration. Three unexcused tardies to the same class equals one unexcused absence.

5th Tardy: 1 Hour Work Detail

6th Tardy: 3 Hours Saturday School

7th Tardy: 1 Full Day in ATS

8th Tardy: Various Hours to be Determined of Work Detail/Saturday School

9th Tardy: Various Hours to be Determined of Work Detail/After School Detention/Saturday School

10th Tardy: Meeting with Student, Parent and Administrators

website. First place winners in each division will also receive a CASH PRIZE and will be recognized at a Virginia PTA Awards Event.
