

# Enrollment Application

## to Queens Lake Middle School Arts Magnet

I wish to apply for admission for my son or daughter to the Queens Lake Middle School (QLMS) Arts Magnet beginning in the **2022-2023** school year. I understand that acceptance and enrollment in the program is a one year commitment and that students zoned for schools other than QLMS are required to enroll in Queens Lake Middle School. Additionally, I understand that if my child is zoned for a school other than QLMS, I am responsible for providing transportation either to/from QLMS or to/from an existing QLMS bus stop. Completed applications must be received in the main office of Queens Lake Middle School, 124 West Queens Drive, Williamsburg, VA 23185 by **4:00 p.m. April 22, 2022**.

I understand that my child’s eligibility for the lottery to attend the Middle School Arts Magnet is based on the following requirements:

- Received a “B” or above in the first semester or most recent semester of his/her English class.
- Received a passing score (400 or above) on the English: Reading Standards of Learning assessment in the previous school year (or an equivalent achievement test from another state).
- A record of good attendance and citizenship.

**NOTE:** If your child is ineligible for the middle school lottery based on these requirements, you will be contacted. Applicants for mSAM in grades 6 and 7 who do not currently meet these criteria may choose to reapply for admission next year.

Continued participation in mSAM will be based on a review of the student’s academic and behavior record at the end of each school year.

- To continue your child must maintain a “C” or above in all mSAM classes and achieve a passing score (400 or above) on the Reading SOL assessment for the current year.
- A School Division Committee will review repeated behavioral offenses that result in multiple suspensions and determine if the student will continue to participate.
