<b>A</b> Always Respectful	Listening without interrupting	Using good manners (Example: "Please" and "Thank you")	Listening and following all household rules	Using positive and appropriate language	Resolving conflicts peacefully with all family members	Using an inside voice
<b>I</b> Intellectual	Doing your own work	Making healthy choices	Returning home by curfew	Responding to parent(s) promptly	Using their best judgement when making decisions	Listening to parents
<b>L</b> Leadership	Participating in their community	Making positive choices	Being kind and respectful to others	Setting a positive example for other family members	Helping younger siblings with homework	Getting ready and going to bed on time
